- Storage and consumption of alcohol are prohibited during your stay with BTG.

**Clothing Guide:**

Dress code for ministry includes:

**DRUGS AND ALCOHOL:**

Alcohol, tobacco, and drugs are not allowed while serving on mission or onsite at the BTG mission center.

**BE REASONABLE:**

In our effort to minister in another culture, we must avoid offending others and hurting the efforts of the missionaries. To achieve this, you may have to sacrifice your personal liberties. These are "institutional standards" which we believe will help us have a good testimony in the various cultures and circumstances we will be involved in.

**PHYSICAL CONTACT:**

There should be no physical contact between males and females that could be perceived to be more than platonic.

**SHARING PERSONAL INFO:**

Be aware that sharing personal information with other people comes with risks. It is recommended that you exercise caution and discernment in this area.

**CULTURAL EXPECTATIONS:**

Because Zambians are very affectionate people it is not uncommon to see men or women holding hands with members of the same sex for long periods of time to express non-sexual endearment for one another.

**HELPING:**

BTG believes every man, woman, and child has been given gifts from God that should be cultivated and utilized to help them reach their God given purpose and potential. With this in mind, we firmly believe in the strategy of giving people a hand up and not a hand out.
